## About the position

Each week we distribute our VegBoxes to the community. Vegetable bag packers help prepare our boxes and bags for delivery. This is a voluntary role, every Thursday 8am-11am, with the option to stay on into the afternoon to help with growing activities. We are looking for a minimum commitment of 3 months - ideally weekly or fortnightly.

This involves working alongside our team in our packing shed: handling and weighing the vegetables; packing the produce into bags ready for distribution; labelling and sorting VegBoxes into routes and observing health and safety and food hygiene requirements.

## Person specification

The role would suit someone who:

- wishes to gain work-experience in distribution, retail and/or the food industry
- would benefit from getting more physically active;
- enjoys the camaraderie of working with a friendly team;
- wants to get involved with Sutton Community Farm.
- Candidates for this role need to be physically fit and willing to work both as part of a team and unsupervised (once training has been given). You will also be committed to observing health and safety and food hygiene requirements.
